Individuals can then use those verifiable credentials for medical purposes and to demonstrate their vaccination status to safely participate in the reopening of our society and economies.



About SMART Health Cards

What is a SMART Health Card?

A SMART Health Card is a paper or digital version of an individual's clinical information, such as vaccination history or test results. They allow individuals to keep a copy of their records on hand and easily share this information with others if they choose.

When scanned, a verifier can easily authenticate the information on the card, making SMART Health Cards a safe and reliable way to demonstrate health status.




Sample SMART Health Card (paper and digital)

The lifecycle of a SMART Health Card

There are several parties involved in the transfer of the information contained in a SMART Health Card, from its origin to its use in realworld situations where trustworthy, secure, verifiable clinical information is needed.



A **Trust Framework** is a registry of known Issuers a Verifier may check to ensure information is trustworthy.

How are SMART Health Cards Verified?


There are a number of ways to verify SMART Health Cards



The free <u>SMART Health Card Verifier</u> <u>App</u> is available to everyone. It checks that SMART Health Cards are valid and were issued by trusted issuers in the <u>VCI Trusted Issuer Registry</u> and <u>CommonTrust Network</u>
